Speaker of the National Assembly of the Republic of Korea

Ui Hwa CHUNG was born in 1948 and became a medical scientist by training. Since the mid-1970 Chung advanced his studies in the field of neurosurgery to become director of a neurosurgery hospital in the early 1980s. However, after he received his PhD in medical science from Yonsei University in 1995, Chung started his political career only one year later when in his home town Pusan he was elected into the National Assembly for the New Korea Party. Since then he was reelected five times and served on various important parliamentary committees as well as in high positions of his party such as vice-floor leader. Since spring 2014 he is serving his second term speaker of the National Assembly after his first election in 2012.
