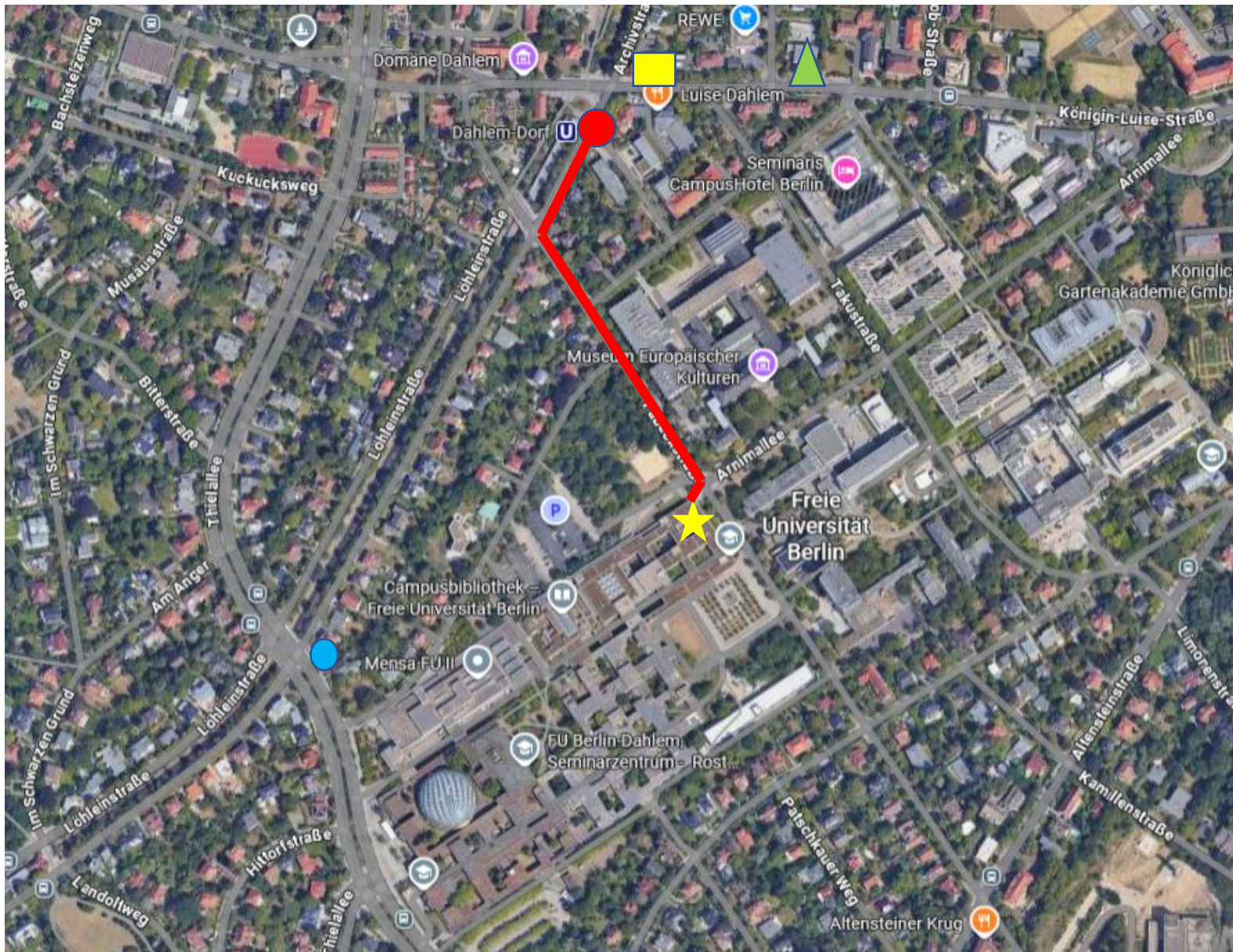
We look forward to seeing anyone who wants to come!
