If the supervisor's membership at Freie Universität Berlin ends, he or she retains the right to complete the supervision of a dissertation that has been started and to be a member of the doctoral committee with voting right for an additional four years; section 9.2 p.2 remains unaffected (see section 6.9 p.1).

All university lecturers who have retired after October 23, 1990, are, as of retirement, no longer members of the university thus they are considered external members with regard to the composition of the doctoral committee.
