All professors who have obtained emeritus status after October 23, 1990, are not considered members of the university; instead, they are considered external members for the purposes of the composition of the doctoral commission.

In this case, and in the case of supervision by external supervisors, Sec. 6 (5) of the abovementioned Doctoral Study Regulations stipulates that the application for admission must be accompanied by a free-form declaration from a full-time professor at the Department regarding support for the external supervisor.

Please see the provisions of Sec. 8 (2) of the abovementioned Doctoral Study Regulations: (2) The supervisor responsible for the dissertation project must be appointed as one of the reviewers of the dissertation. The doctoral committee designates one additional reviewer by agreement with the doctoral candidate. At least one reviewer must be a full-time professor at the Department.
